When your resource is ready to submit, go to <http://www.learnhigher.ac.uk> and select the 'submit resource' tab at the top of the home page. After reading through the guidelines, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on 'submit a resource' to start the submission process. There are 3 steps to the submission process.
