



# LearnHigher Resource Criteria

The following explains the types of resources that we are looking for, the information that you will need to provide and the format these resources can be in:

Your resources should meet the following criteria:

- A teaching resource for university level students
- Cover an area of Learning Development
- Be adaptable
- Can be in a variety of formats e.g. videos, lesson plans, online tutorials, presentations etc
- Should have creative commons licencing agreement in order that they can be freely reused and repurposed

You will be asked for information on:

- Author and institution
- Brief description of resource
- Estimated activity time
- Any additional resources that may be required
- Type of media it uses
- Agreement of a creative commons licence
- The categories within the site you feel the resource best sits

The site is able to accommodate resources in the following formats and sizes:

- doc, docx, xls, xlsx, ppt, pptx, csv,txt, rtf, html, zip, mp3, wma, mpg, flv, avi, jpg, jpeg, png, gif, wav, swf
- Multiple files are allowed
- Maximum size per file is 20MB
- To check the size of your file: hover over your file within your folder and the size will be displayed.
